Sub: **Guidelines on admission to the Diploma Course in Pharmacy in Government and Self-Financed Institutions during the Academic Session 2021-22**

Sir / Madam,

This is for your information that this Council has prepared the Merit List for admission of students to the Diploma Course in Pharmacy during the academic session 2021-22 from amongst the applicants, who have submitted the marks of their qualifying examination and other details through online portal of the Council, and published the same on 08.11.2021. The Council also issued Provisional e-Rank Card to all merit listed candidates. The online counselling for admission to the aforesaid course will be made based on the aforesaid Merit List, in accordance with the following schedule.

Registration & Choice Filling	:	From 08.11.2021 to 16.11.2021
Allotment Results of 1st Phase	:	17.11.2021
Admission / Provisional Seat Booking of 1st Phase	:	From 17.11.2021 to 22.11.2021
Allotment Results of 2nd Phase	:	23.11.2021
Last date of Admission in 2nd Phase	:	From 24.11.2021 to 29.11.2021

The eligibility criteria for admission to the Diploma Course in Pharmacy for the Academic Session 2021-22, modalities for determination of the Merit List and other aspects are enumerated below:—

Eligibility Criteria:


1. Candidates must be an Indian Citizen.
2. Candidates must pass Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination in General Stream Course with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics. Candidates passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent examination in Vocational Stream Courses are not eligible for admission, as per prescribed admission eligibility of Pharmacy Council of India.
3. The candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year for admission to the Pharmacy Course. There is no upper age limit.
4. Reservation of Seats for SC, ST and PC (Physically Challenged or Handicapped) category candidates in Government level institutions will be as per the existing norms of the Government. Candidates have to produce their original SC, ST or PC certificates issued by the competent authority of the State of West Bengal at the time of provisional admission. SC/ST candidates of the States other than West Bengal will not get the benefit of such reservation.

Modalities followed for determination of the Merit List:

- a) Rank of the candidate in the merit list has been made on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.
- b) If two or more candidates have scored same marks, the one who got higher marks in Chemistry has been given preference in ranking.
- c) If two or more candidates have scored same marks, the one who got higher marks in Physics has been given preference in ranking.
- d) If two or more candidates have scored same marks, the one who secured higher marks in Biology or Mathematics got preference in ranking.
- e) Even if the tie exists, candidates who scored higher marks in Biology got preference.
- f) After all these calculations, if the marks of more than one applicant became same, the applicant who is senior in age has been given higher rank in the merit list.

Other Aspects:

- i) 75% of the approved intakes of the Self-Financed Institutions affiliated to the WBSCT&VE&SD shall be filled-up from the candidates having valid rank in the Merit List.
- ii) The remaining 25% of the approved intakes of the Self-Financed Institutions will be the Management Quota seats and that will be filled-up by the respective Self-Financed Institutions from the candidates in accordance with the Eligibility Criteria mentioned hereinabove.
- iii) Fee structure will remain unchanged as stated in G.O. No. 528-TET(Poly)/11C-08/2009 dated 29.07.2009 of the Department of Technical Education, Training & Skill Development.
